



Dear KASE Member:

On May 15, 2007, the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance issued Advisory Opinion 2007-001. That opinion stated that we can now solicit voluntary contributions from individual members for permanent political action committee (PAC), so long as the solicitation is directed to you as a member of this organization.

In order for KASE to be more effect in the legislative process, we must engage in the political process by making donations to political campaigns. We must financially support those candidates who support our issues. Our contributions to political campaigns will be on a non-partisan basis. Again, we will support those candidates who support and fight for our issues. To that end, KASE now has a COPE (Committee on Political Education) PAC. The name of our PAC is Kentucky Public Employees, PAC.

We are soliciting your voluntary contributions to help support our PAC. Under the provisions of KRS 121.150 (10), a person may contribute **no more** than \$1500 per year to all permanent committees, in the aggregate.
